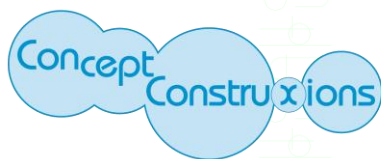


After-school Workshops April - June, 2010

“Academic Vocabulary Development and Differentiated Instruction in Math and Science”

This special focus provides 13 events across all 5 boroughs, from late April through June. All modeled strategies invoke critical thinking and are deeply connected to building content knowledge--they are not stand-alone literacy activities for math and science. This two-hour workshop is our “Orientation” session. At our Summer Invitational In August and into next year, EduChange will offer opportunities for the second and third levels of PD.

The Details...Please read carefully!

- The NYCDOE is sponsoring this event, so participation is free. The DOE also is sponsoring the provision of *Concept Construxions*[®] materials to schools. Teachers must participate in the workshops to receive *Concept Construxions*[®] materials.
- Math and science teachers, their CTT partners and Special Educators, EL specialists, APs and others who support math and science learning in Grades 6-12 are eligible to attend. Priority will be given to schools sending more teachers. ****Note:** The HS sciences targeted in these workshops are: Living Environment, Earth Science and Chemistry only. The HS Math courses targeted are: Integrated Algebra and Geometry only.
- Timeframe: 4:00 - 6:00 pm. We will start promptly. Teachers will receive payment for 2 hours at the training rate.
- Locations: These after-school workshops will be held at volunteer host schools. Host schools will be finalized on a first-come-first-served basis, and directions, school locations, and other details will be provided to enrolled participants via email.
- Be a Host School: Host schools provide a single room (preferably a classroom) that seats 35 adults comfortably, with a screen or white board for projection. Host schools receive their materials first and, of course, their teachers don't have to travel! K-8 and 6-12 schools can serve as host schools.
- MS and HS Workshops: It is important that *MS educators enroll only in the MS workshops*, and vice versa for HS. Math and science teachers will be combined at each level. It is possible for teachers to attend any date at their level, and for teachers from the same school to attend different dates.
